

## **Fire Action** Any person discovering a fire

1. Repeatedly shout 'Fire' to warn everyone in the boathouse / race box.

2. Ensure everyone in the boathouse / race box is aware of fire and need to evacuate.

3. Leave premises immediately by safest exit ensuring no one is left behind.

4. When safe to do so dial 999 and ask for fire service – state fire at the lakeside boathouse, north side, Shearwater Lake Crockerton BA12 8AE.
5. Keep everyone including the public at least 50m away from the start box as potential gas cylinder explosion hazard and petrol explosion hazard.

## Safe assembly area is outside the Clubhouse.



Do not stop to collect personal belongings. Do not re-enter the start box or boathouse until told that it is safe to do so by the fire service.

## Any person discovering a fire

 Ring club bell continuously if possible.
 In any event repeatedly shout 'Fire'.
 Ensure everyone in the building is aware of fire and need to evacuate.
 Leave clubhouse immediately by safest exit ensuring no one is left behind.
 When safe to do so dial 999 and ask for fire service – state fire at Shearwater Sailing Club, Shearwater Lake Crockerton BA12 8AE.
 Keep everyone including the public at least 50m away from the club house as potential gas cylinder explosion hazard.

Safe assembly area is outside 'Fisherman's Rest' café at the entrance to the lake.



Do not stop to collect personal belongings. Do not re-enter club house until told that it is safe to do so by the fire service.
